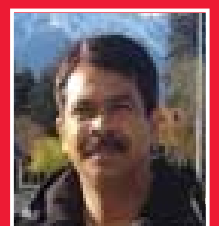
> Mike Rann has been Premier of South Australia since 2002. Upon taking office, he also became Australia’s first Minister for Sustainability and Climate Change, and his Government became the first jurisdiction in the nation - and the third in the world - to introduce dedicated Climate Change legislation. He has also served as co-Chair of the UK-based Climate Group’s International States and Regions’ Alliance.
